6th WORLD URBAN FORUM

UN Habitat will organise the 6th World Urban Forum in **Naples on 1st - 7th September 2012**. The event will bring together governmental and municipal authorities, representatives of civil society, professionals, academics, and representatives of the private sector around the theme **The Urban Future**.

Four major topics were chosen for the discussions - Urban Planning: institutions and regulations; Improving the quality of life; Equity and Prosperity: distribution of wealth and opportunities; Productive Cities: competitive and innovative cities and urban mobility, energy & environment. Discussions should lead to an adaptation of the **Manifesto for Cities** that lays out **the foundations for a world urban agenda**.



373 CANDIDATES TO DESIGN A BIOCLIMATIC SCHOOL IN CRETE

This innovative, **bioclimatic architecture competition**, organised with the support of UIA and its **ARES (Architecture and renewable energy sources) work programme**, generated a wave of enthusiasm, with 373 participants from 57 countries. A strong majority of registrants are European, with a significant presence from Asian countries. Japanese architect **Ben Nakamura** will represent the UIA on the competition jury when it meets next October.

NEW ZEALAND ARCHITECTURE MEDAL 2012

Auckland **Art Gallery Toi o Tāmaki** was awarded the 2012 New Zealand Architecture Medal, which is part of a series of awards attributed by the New Zealand Institute of Architects every year. **FJMT and Archimedia architects** designed this structure in accord with a complex programme requiring urban integration within a sensitive area and adding on to a historic building. According to the jury members, the authors responded brilliantly, and an overwhelming majority of the population of Auckland agrees.

WOMEN ARCHITECTS FEATURED ON NZIA WEBSITE



The NZIA website is turning the spotlight on New Zealand's women architects by creating a series of pages entitled Architecture+Women. The goal is to constitute a database and set up an open **network of all the women architects with ties to New Zealand**, whatever their mode of practice or their activities.

It includes a ten-point questionnaire that will help gather statistics, and the project will be utilised to create an exhibition for 2013 that shows the constants and mutations in the professional careers of women architects over the last 20 years. **RAFAEL MONEO - 2012 PRINCE OF ASTURIAS PRIZE IN ARTS**

Spanish architect Rafael Moneo, following the abundance of honours received from around the world, was awarded the 2012 Prince of Asturias Prize in Arts, in Oviedo, capital of the Principality of Asturias, for his "invaluable contribution to the cultural and architectural heritage of humanity". Considered one of the greatest contemporary Spanish architects, he is also respected and honoured on the international scale for his exemplary realisations including the Atocha train station, the extension of the Prado Museum in Madrid, the Modern Art Museum in Stockholm, and the Our Lady of the Angels cathedral in Los Angeles.

Rafael Moneo won the Pritzker Prize and the **UIA Gold Medal in 1996**.

Among the themes suggested for ideas are preservation projects, the extension of waterside and beach walkways, protecting the environment and natural spaces, and water treatment within the framework of urban and suburban planning and touristic planning programmes.

ENVIRONMENT AND URBAN REGENERATION, VIDEOS NOW ONLINE



**HOLISTIC HOUSING. HOW TO DESIGN IN A SUSTAINABLE FASHION**

Hans Drexler and Sebastian El khouli have co-authored a book entitled *Holistic Housing. Concepts, design strategies and processes*. The work explores sustainable solutions in the context of planification, but also according to usage and the entire life cycle of a structure. A set of criteria allow for a comparison and evaluation of buildings, and can also be used to optimise the design process. Fifteen examples explain the ways in which these criteria and other aspects of sustainable building can be implemented in sophisticated architecture and how these can then be experienced.

The book is available in English and German. It contains 288 pages in 24 x 33 format and is published by **DETAIL**. It sells for 49 euro.
